Invisible Braces



Invisible braces for teeth are custom-made, clear, plastic dental aligners similar to mouth guards used in athletics. These braces are removable and are replaced every two weeks. They are almost invisible. While wearing them, patients can eat and drink whatever they want.

This keeps the ball on the clubface slightly longer, so that the ball spins harder. When it lands, it digs in and stops more quickly

Infrared Thermometers



Once, nurses took your temperature with a glass thermometer under your tongue. It was slow waiting until the reading stopped changing, shaking the thermometer, and sterilizing it. Today, a nurse points a device into your ear or onto your forehead to take your temperature. It quickly measures thermal radiation from your eardrum without touching you.
